

Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2014

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THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2014**.

2. In these regulations —

“principal regulations” means the Consumer Protection (Export Control) Regulations 2000.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new definition —

“value” means value as determined under section 18 of the Customs Act, provided that the sequence of section 18(2)(c) and (d) shall not under any circumstance be reversed.

4. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended —

(a) in paragraph (1), by deleting the words “paragraph (2)” and replacing them by the words “paragraphs (2) and (3)”;

(b) by adding the following new paragraph —

(3) No export permit shall be required in respect of a sample of controlled goods bearing H.S. Codes 50.01-63.10 where —

- (a) it is being exported for the purpose of analysis or marketing only;
and
- (b) its value does not exceed 250 US dollars.

5. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 October 2014.
