## Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2014

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## THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

## Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2014.
- 2. In these regulations —

"principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Export Control) Regulations 2000.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new definition —

"value" means value as determined under section 18 of the Customs Act, provided that the sequence of section 1 8(2)(c) and (d) shall not under any circumstance be reversed.

- **4.** Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended
  - (a) in paragraph (1), by deleting the words "paragraph (2)" and replacing them by the words "paragraphs (2) and (3)";
  - (b) by adding the following new paragraph
    - (3) No export permit shall be required in respect of a sample of controlled goods bearing H.S. Codes 50.01-63.10 where —

- (a) it is being exported for the purpose of analysis or marketing only;and
- (b) its value does not exceed 250 US dollars.
- **5.** These regulations shall come into operation on 1 October 2014.
