THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment) Regulations 2015**.
- 2.** In these regulations —
“principal regulations” means the Consumer Protection (Export Control) Regulations 2000.
- 3.** Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definition —

“TradeNet” has the same meaning as in the Customs (Use of Computer) Regulations 1997;
- 4.** Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph 3(a), by inserting, after the word “furnish”, the words “, electronically through the TradeNet,”.
- 5.** Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended —

(a) in paragraph (1), by deleting the words “such computer system via”;

(b) by revoking paragraph (2).
- 6.** These regulations shall come into operation on 1 April 2015.
