THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Control of Fairs) (Amendment) Regulations 2023.
- 2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Control of Fairs) Regulations 2016.

- **3.** Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking paragraph (2) and replacing it by the following paragraph -
 - (2) (a) Subject to paragraph (b), a person who intends to hold a fair shall, not less than one month before the proposed first day of the fair, make an application to the Permanent Secretary in the form set out in the Second Schedule;
 - (b) Notwithstanding subparagraph (a), an application where at least one foreign participant will participate, shall be made at least 2 months before the proposed first day of the fair in the form set out in the Second Schedule.
