THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) (Amendment** No. 2) Regulations 2022.

2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) Regulations 2017.

3. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by deleting item 15 and replacing it by the following item -

- 15. Incandescent lamps, excluding -
 - (a) bulbs used in medical equipment;
 - (b) infrared lamps;
 - (c) appliance bulbs;
 - (d) red heat lamps;
 - (e) ultraviolet lamps;
 - (f) flashlight bulbs;
 - (g) projector lamps;
 - (h) signal lamps;
 - (i) sealed beam lamps of 12 or 24 volts; and
 - (j) automotive halogen bulbs of 6, 12 or 24 volts, but not exceeding 75 Watts.
- 4. These regulations shall come into operation on 2 May 2022.
