THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 2023**.
2. In these regulations —
"principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) Regulations 2017.
3. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended —
 - (a) in paragraph (1), by deleting the words "paragraph (2)" and replacing them by the words "paragraph (2) or (3)";
 - (b) by adding the following new paragraph —
 - (3) (a) Notwithstanding these regulations but subject to this paragraph, no import permit shall be required in respect of a second-hand motor vehicle, including a left-hand drive second-hand motor vehicle, which is imported for rally purposes, provided that —
 - (i) the motor vehicle is imported for such restricted period as the National Land Transport Authority may approve;
 - (ii) the motor vehicle is imported in accordance with customs laws;
 - (iii) the importer of the motor vehicle furnishes a security to the Director-General in such amount as he may determine; and
 - (iv) the motor-vehicle is covered by a visitor's licence issued by the National Land Transport Authority on such terms and conditions as it may determine.
 - (b) A motor vehicle imported pursuant to paragraph (a) shall —
 - (i) not, under any circumstance, be sold on the local market; and
 - (ii) be re-exported by the expiry of the restricted period, except where the motor vehicle has been destroyed by accident or force majeure, or lost.
4. These regulations shall come into operation on 10 July 2023.
