THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) (Amendment) Regulations 2023.
- In these regulations –
 "principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) Regulations 2017.
- 3. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended, in Part I
 - (a) by revoking paragraph 6 and replacing it by the following paragraph
 - **6.** Returning resident or spouse of a returning resident, without any transfer of funds from Mauritius.
 - (b) by inserting, after paragraph 6, the following new paragraph
 - **6A.** (a) A Mauritian receiving as gift, for his own use, a second-hand motor vehicle owned by his father, mother, brother, sister, son or daughter staying abroad, without any transfer of funds from Mauritius.
 - (b) In this paragraph
 - "second-hand motor vehicle" does not include a van and double-cab heavy duty lorry.
- 4. These regulations shall come into operation on 24 April 2023.
