THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the

Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

- These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Sale of Pre-Packed Food) Regulations 2022.
- 2. In these regulations -

"best-before date" has the same meaning as in the Food Regulations 1999;

"Pre-packed food" has the same meaning as in the Food Regulations 1999.

- **3.** No pre-packed food whose best-before date has lapsed shall be displayed for sale unless its bestbefore date is conspicuously labelled on that pre-packed food.
- **4.** Every pre-packed food shall, not later than 7 days after the best-before date has lapsed, be sold at not less than 50 per cent of its original selling price.
- **5.** These regulations shall come into operation on 1 October 2022
