THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

**Regulations made by the Minister under sections 3 and 35 of the Consumer
Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Control of Price of Taxable and Non-taxable Goods) (Amendment No. 5) Regulations 2022**.

2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Control of Price of Taxable and Non-taxable Goods) Regulations 1998.

3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended, under the heading "**Petroleum Products**", by deleting the following items and their corresponding entries -

Gas Oil	47.5300 per litre	49.6000 per litre
Mogas	65.3300 per litre	67.4000 per litre

and replacing them by the following items and their corresponding entries -

Gas Oil	52.4800 per litre	54.5500 per litre
Mogas	72.0300 per litre	74.1000 per litre

4. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended, in Part I. under the item "**Petroleum Products**", by deleting the following sub-item -

Dual Purpose Kerosene (DPK)

Illuminating Kerosene

(1)	When sold by oil companies	64.6970	per litre
(2)	When sold by distributors or petrol service stations	12,952.40	per drum of 200 litres
(3)	When sold by petrol service stations	65.40	per litre
(4)	When sold by retailers, other than petrol service stations	13.08	per litre
		13.08	Per measure of 200 ml equivalent of one quart

and by replacing it by the following sub-item –

Dual Purpose Kerosene (DPK) Illuminating Kerosene

(1)	When sold by oil companies	71.3970	per litre
(2)	When sold by distributors or petrol service stations	14,292.40	per drum of 200 litres
(3)	When sold by petrol service stations	72.10	Per litre
(4)	When sold by retailers, other than petrol service stations	14.42	per measure of 200 ml equivalent of one quart

5. These regulations shall come into operation on 19 May 2022.
