**Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the  
Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act**

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Control of Sale of Imported Live Animals for Home Slaughter) (Amendment) Regulations 2022**.
- 2.** In these regulations -  
  
"principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Control of Sale of Imported Live Animals for Home Slaughter) Regulations 2010.
- 3.** Regulation 6A of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the following regulation -  
  
**6A.** (1) The retail selling price of imported live cattle shall, during the specified period, not exceed 170 rupees per kilogramme.  
  
(2) In this regulation -  
  
"specified period" means the period starting on 1 July 2022 to the day following 2 days after the religious ceremony of Eid-UI-Adha in the year 2022.
- 4.** These regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 2022.
