### THE CIVIL STATUS ACT

## Regulations made by the Minister under sections 35 and 75 of the Civil Status Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Civil Status (Fees for Marriages) (Amendment) Regulations 2022.
- 2. In these regulations -

"Act" means the Civil Status Act;

"principal regulations" means the Civil Status (Fees for Marriages) Regulations 2003.

- 3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the following new regulation -
  - **3.** The fee payable under section 35(1)(b) of the Act shall be as specified in the Schedule.
- **4.** The Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 5. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 May 2022.
