## Central Water Authority (Water Supply for Domestic Purposes) (Amendment) Regulations 2022

## THE CENTRAL WATER AUTHORITY ACT

Regulations made by the Central Water Board, with the approval of the Minister, under section 49 of the Central Water Authority Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Central Water Authority (Water Supply for Domestic Purposes) (Amendment) Regulations 2022.
- 2. In these regulations
  - "COVID-19 period" has the same meaning as in the Interpretation and General Clauses Act;
    "principal regulations" means the Central Water Authority (Water Supply for Domestic Purposes)
    Regulations 2011.
- 3. Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is amended
  - (a) by inserting, after paragraph (2), the following new paragraph
    - (2A) Where the time period of 21 days expires, or falls, wholly or partly, during the COVID-19 period, no surcharge shall, notwithstanding paragraph (2), be imposed and the water supply shall not be disconnected, provided that the amount of fees, rates, charges or other duties that the consumer owed to the Central Water Authority is paid not later than 4 months as from 30 April 2021.
  - (b) by inserting after paragraph (3), the following new paragraph
    - (3A) Where the time period of 35 days expires, or falls, wholly or partly, during the COVID-19 period, no surcharge shall, notwithstanding paragraph (3), be imposed and the water supply shall not be disconnected, provided that the amount of fees, rates, charges or other duties that the consumer owed to the Central Water Authority is paid not later than 4 months as from 30 April 2021.
  - **4.** These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 April 2021.
