## Central Water Authority (Dry Season) (Amendment No. 5) Regulations 2023

## **CENTRAL WATER AUTHORITY ACT**

Regulations made by the Central Water Board, with the approval of the Minister, under section 49 of the Central Water Authority Act

- These regulations may be cited as the Central Water Authority (Dry Season) (Amendment No. 5) Regulations 2023.
- In these regulations —"principal regulations" means the Central Water Authority (Dry Season) Regulations 2022.
- 3. Regulations 4 of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the following regulation \_\_\_
  - **4.** (1) For the purpose of irrigation of sugarcane, any person entitled to carry out irrigation of sugarcane may, for the period starting on 1 August 2023 and ending on 31 August 2023, abstract water from a watercourse, provided that
    - (a) the watercourse does not feed any impounding reservoir; or
    - (b) the Authority does not abstract water from any watercourse for the purpose of providing water for domestic purposes.
    - (2) Any abstraction of water from a watercourse under paragraph (1)
      - (a) may be subject to such terms and conditions as may be deemed necessary; and
      - (b) shall not cause prejudice to any interest that a person may hold in that watercourse.
    - (3) Sugarcane irrigation in the Northern Plain from the Midlands-La Nicolière Reservoirs system shall be carried out, on days and during the time specified in the Schedule, in accordance with such recommendations as the Water Resources Monitoring Committee may take.
- **4.** Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the words "31 July 2023" and replacing them by the words "31 August 2023".
