THE DENTAL COUNCIL ACT

Regulations made by the Dental Council of Mauritius, with the approval of the Minister, under section 40 of the Dental Council Act

- **1.** These regulations may be cited as the Dental Council (Registration of Dental Surgeons and Dental Specialists) (Amendment) Regulations 2022.
- 2. In these regulations
 - "principal regulations" means the Dental Council (Registration of Dental Surgeons and Dental Specialists) Regulations 2000.
- **3.** The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after regulation 413, the following new regulation –
- **4C.** (1) The Registrar may, where the Council is satisfied of the good character of the registered dental practitioner, issue a certificate of good standing to the registered dental practitioner.
 - (2) The certificate of good standing shall be issued on payment of a fee of 2,000 rupees.
- 4. Regulation of the principal regulations is amended -
 - (a) in paragraph (1) -
 - (i) in subparagraph (a), by deleting the words "2,500 rupees" and replacing them by the words "5,000 rupees";
 - (ii) in subparagraph (b), by deleting the words "5,000 rupees" and replacing them by the words "10,000 rupees";
 - (iii) in subparagraph (c), by deleting the words "5,000 rupees" and replacing them by the words "25,000 rupees";
 - (iv) in subparagraph (d), by deleting the words "10,000 rupees" and replacing them by the words "50,000 rupees";
 - (b) in paragraph (3) -
 - (i) in subparagraph (a), by deleting the words "2,500 rupees" and "5,000 rupees" and replacing them by the words "5,000 rupees" and "10,000 rupees", respectively;
 - (ii) in subparagraph (b), by deleting the words "5,000 rupees" and "10,000 rupees" and replacing them by the words "25,000 rupees" and "50,000 rupees", respectively;

- (iii) in subparagraph (c), by deleting the words "3,750 rupees" and "7,500 rupees" and replacing them by the words "7,500 rupees" and "15,000 rupees", respectively;
- (iv) in subparagraph (d), by deleting the words "7,500 rupees" and "15,000 rupees" and replacing them by the words "37,500 rupees" and "75,000 rupees", respectively;
- 5. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 December 2022.
