THE DENTAL COUNCIL ACT

Regulations made by the Dental Council of Mauritius, with the approval of the Minister, under section 40 of the Dental Council Act

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Dental Council (Additional Qualifications) Regulations 2023**.
- 2.** In these regulations -
 “Act” means the Dental Council Act.
- 3.** Where, after registration, a registered person obtains a qualification from a medical institution, the Council may, on application made to it pursuant to section 28 of the Act, add the qualification to the register if the Council is satisfied, on the basis of documentary evidence, that the qualification -
 - (a) is related to the field of dentistry; and
 - (b) has been obtained -
 - (i) in respect of a clinical subject, after a full-time clinical training of a duration of at least one academic year which is not exclusively by distance learning;
 - (ii) in respect of a non-clinical subject, after -
 - (A) a full-time training of a duration of at least one academic year; or
 - (B) a part-time training of a duration of at least 2 academic years;
 - (iii) after an examination.
- 4.** The Council may, for the purpose of regulation 3, interview the registered person.
