THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 60 of the Dangerous Drugs Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Dangerous Drugs (Prescribed Forms) (Amendment) Regulations 2024**.

2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Dangerous Drugs (Prescribed Forms) Regulations 2001.

3. The principal regulations are amended by adding the following new regulation -

10. The application form for the destruction of dangerous drugs under section 58A of the Act shall be as set out in the Third Schedule.

4. The principal regulations are amended by adding the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

- (e) following the request of the accused -
 - *(j) the accused did not cause further analysis of the dangerous drugs after the lapsing of the 30 days' period of the request; or
