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THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 60 of
the Dangerous Drugs Act**

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the **Dangerous Drugs (Prescribed Forms) (Amendment) Regulations 2024**.
- 2. In these regulations -
"principal regulations" means the Dangerous Drugs (Prescribed Forms) Regulations 2001.
- 3. The principal regulations are amended by adding the following new regulation -
10. The application form for the destruction of dangerous drugs under section 58A of the Act shall be as set out in the Third Schedule.
- 4. The principal regulations are amended by adding the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

APPLICATION FOR DESTRUCTION OF DANGEROUS DRUGS SEIZED

[Under section 58A of the Dangerous Drugs Act]

*(j) the accused did not cause further analysis of the dangerous drugs after the lapsing of
the 30 days' period of the request; or

*(ii) on (date), the accused caused, under my supervision,
another sample of the dangerous drugs/ net amount of the dangerous drugs* to be
further analysed by FSL/ (an accredited
science laboratory)* and the dangerous drugs were identified as
(nature and identity) and having a net weight/extrapolated weight*
