

Dangerous Drugs (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations 2015

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THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 60(2)(b) of the Dangerous Drugs Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Dangerous Drugs (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations 2015**.

2. In these regulations —

“Act” means the Dangerous Drugs Act.

3. The First Schedule to the Act is amended —

(a) in Part I, by adding the following new items —

Khat

Lisdexamphetamine

Methoxetamine

N-benzylpiperazine (also named BZP)

(b) in Part II, by adding the following new items —

Methiopropamine (also named MPA)

Synthetic Cathinones, their chemical diversities and derivatives, including —

4-Fluoromethcathinone (also named flephedrone or

4-FMC)

4-Methyl cathinone (also named mephedrone)

4-Methylmethcathinone (also named 4MMC)

3,4-Methylenedioxypropylvalerone (also named 4 MDPV)

4-Methylethcathinone (also named 4 MEC)
Methylone (also named bk-MDMA)
4-Tetrahydrocannabinol (also named 4THC)

4. The Second Schedule to the Act is amended, by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new item —
Flunitrazepam

5. The Third Schedule to the Act is amended —
(a) by deleting the item “Flunitrazepam”, and

(b) by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new items —

Pregabalin (its chemical diversities, including its derivatives and related substance)
Tapentadol

6. The Fourth Schedule to the Act is amended, by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new items —

1,4 Butanediol (also named 1 ,4BD) (its chemical diversities, including its derivatives and related substances)

Gamma-butyrolactone (also named GBL) (its chemical diversities, including its derivatives and related substances)

7. These regulations shall come into operation on 11 September 2015.
