Declaration of Assets (Mauritius Prisons Service) Regulations 2022

THE DECLARATION OF ASSETS ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 13 of the Declaration of Assets Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the **Declaration of Assets (Mauritius Prisons Service) Regulations 2022**.
- 2. In these regulations -

"Act" means the Declaration of Assets Act;

"officer of the Mauritius Prisons Service" means an officer of the Mauritius Prisons Service under the Reform Institutions Act;

"senior officer of the Mauritius Prisons Service" means an officer of the Mauritius Prisons Service of the grade of, or drawing salary in a scale the initial point of which is equivalent to the initial point of the salary scale of, Deputy Permanent Secretary and above.

- **3.** For the purpose of section 3(1)(i) of the Act, the Act shall apply to every officer of the Mauritius Prisons Service.
- **4.** (1) Subject to paragraph (2), every officer of the Mauritius Prisons Service in office at the commencement of these regulations shall, not later than 90 days after the commencement of these regulations, make a declaration of his assets and liabilities with ICAC, including the assets and liabilities of his spouse, his minor children and, subject to section 4(4) of the Act, his children of age and grandchildren.
- (2) Where, before the commencement of these regulations, a senior officer of the Mauritius Prisons Service has, pursuant to the Act, made a declaration of his assets and liabilities with ICAC, that senior officer of the Mauritius Prisons Service shall not be required to make a new declaration of his assets and liabilities under these regulations.
- **5.** These regulations shall come into operation on 4 April 2022.
