# Regulations made by the Minister under section 94 of the Employment Relations Act

- **1.** These regulations may be cited as the Distributive Trades (Remuneration Order) (Amendment) Regulations 2014.
- 2. In these regulations
  - "principal regulations" means the Distributive Trades (Remuneration Order) Regulations 2004.
- **3.** Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (2), by deleting the words "Additional Remuneration (2013) Act 2012" and replacing them by the words "Additional Remuneration (2014) Act 2013".
- **4.** The First Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **5.** These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2014.
