### **Education (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 2022**

#### THE EDUCATION ACT

#### Regulations made by the Minister under section 38 of the Education Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 2022.
- 2. In these regulations
  - "principal regulations" means the Education Regulations 1957.
- **3.** Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definitions
  - "alternative qualification" means a Bachelor in Education degree or a Post Graduate Qualification in Education from a recognised institution as determined by the Higher Education Commission;
  - "degree" means a degree from a recognised institution in the subject to be taught, as determined by the Higher Education Commission;
  - "equivalent qualification" means a qualification of the same level and in the same subject as required for the post, as determined by the Higher Education Commission;
- **4.** Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (1), by revoking paragraph (b) and replacing it by the following paragraph
  - (b) for the secondary school stage, no person shall teach any subject set out in the Third Schedule, in a secondary school, unless he holds –
    - (i) (A) a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least 5 subjects including English Language obtained at not more than 2 sittings; or
      - (B) Passes not below Grade C in at least 5 subjects including English Language obtained at not more than 2 sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level",
        - provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either -
        - (I) in 5 subjects including & English Language with at least GradeC in any 2 subjects; or
        - (II) in 6 subjects, including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject;

- (ii) a Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least 2 subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education
   "Advanced Level"; and
- (iii) (A) (I) a degree or joint degree in the subject to be taught, or an equivalent qualification; and
  - (II) a Post Graduate Certificate in Education from a recognised institution, or an alternative qualification in Education from a recognised institution; or
  - (B) a B.Ed from the Mauritius Institute of Education in the subject to be taught;
- (iv) for subjects set out in the Fourth Schedule, an educator shall teach that subject provided he holds
  - (A) qualifications as prescribed under sub subparagraphs (i) and (ii); and
  - (B) the required qualifications set out in the Fourth Schedule.
- **5.** For the purpose of regulation 4, in the case of a person not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate, passes in at least 2 subjects at "Principal level" and one subject at "Subsidiary level" including General Paper, obtained at one sitting at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations, shall be sufficient.
- **6.** The principal regulations are amended by adding the Third Schedule and Fourth Schedule set out in the First and Second Schedules to these regulations.
- **7.** These regulations shall not apply to any person who, before the commencement of these regulations, is employed in a public or private secondary school.
- These regulations shall come into operation on 21 December 2022.
