THE HUMAN TISSUE (REMOVAL, PRESERVATION AND TRANSPLANT) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister, on the advice of the Tissue Donation, Removal and Transplant Board, under sections 22 and 28 of the Human Tissue (Removal, Preservation and Transplant) Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Human Tissue (Removal, Preservation and Transplant) (Importation and Use of Corneal Tissue) Regulations 2024.
- 2. In these regulations -

"Act" means the Human Tissue (Removal, Preservation and Transplant) Act.

- 3. For the purpose of section 22 of the Act -
 - (a) an application to the Board for the importation and use of tissue shall be made in the form set out in Part I of the Schedule;
 - (b) an authorisation of the Board for the importation and use of tissue shall be granted in the form set out in Part II of the Schedule; and
 - (c) a refusal of the Board to authorise the importation and use of tissue shall be made in the form set out in Part III of the Schedule.
- **4.** These regulations shall come into operation on 10 January 2024.
