#### THE IMMIGRATION ACT

### Regulations made by the Minister under section 21 of the Immigration Act

- **1.** These regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Permits) (Prescribed Fees, Guarantees and Application Form) (Amendment) Regulations 2014.
- 2. In these regulations "principal regulations" means the Immigration (Permits) (Prescribed Fees, Guarantees and Application Form) Regulations 2011.
- **3.** Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is revoked.
- **4.** The First Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 5. Any bank guarantee which
  - (a) is submitted before 21 December 2013; and
  - (b) has not expired as at 21 December 2013,shall remain valid for the period specified in the bank guarantee.
- 6. Regulations 3 and 5 shall be deemed to have come into operation on 2l December2013.
