**THE IMMIGRATION ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 21 of the Immigration Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Permits) (Prescribed Fees, Guarantees and Application Form) (Amendment) Regulations 2014.
2. In these regulations —  
“principal regulations” means the Immigration (Permits) (Prescribed Fees, Guarantees and Application Form) Regulations 2011.
3. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is revoked.
4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
5. Any bank guarantee which —
  - (a) is submitted before 21 December 2013; and
  - (b) has not expired as at 21 December 2013,  
shall remain valid for the period specified in the bank guarantee.
6. Regulations 3 and 5 shall be deemed to have come into operation on 21 December 2013.

3. Application fee for occupation permit for —	
(a) an investor;	20,000
(b) a self-employed non-citizen;	20,000
(c) an employer of a professional in respect of a contract of employment —	
(i) of not more than 2 years;	15,000
(ii) of more than 2 years but not more than 3 years	20,000
4. Application fee for short-term occupation permit	10,000
5. Application fee for extension of short-term occupation permit	5,000
6. Application fee for residence permit for spouse or common law partner of a person referred to in paragraphs 1 and 3	5,000
