

Motorways and Main Roads (Amendment) Regulations 2021

THE ROADS ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under sections

3(2) and 74 of the Roads Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Motorways and Main Roads (Amendment) Regulations 2021**.
2. In these regulations —
"principal regulations" means the Motorways and Main Roads Regulations 1976.
3. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended —
 - (a) under the heading "MAIN ROADS A", by adding the following new item and its corresponding entries —

Cap Malheureux Bypass	From its junction with Vingt Pieds Road (B45) and Union Road (B1 21) on new Roundabout at Cap Malheureux to its junction with Mon Choisy-Cap Malheureux Road (B13) at Anse la Raie over a total length of 2.25 kilometres	A20

- (b) under the heading "**MAIN ROADS B**" —
 - (i) by deleting item "Mont Choisy-Cap Malheureux Road" and its corresponding entries and replacing it by the following item and its corresponding entries —

Mont Choisy-Cap Malheureux Road	From its junction with A4 through Mont Choisy, Grand Baie, Cap Malheureux, including the new road from Union Ribet Public Beach through its junction with A20 towards Anse La Raie, through Anse La Raie, Petit Paquet, and Saint Francois to its Junction with A5 at Reunion Maurel	B 13

(ii) by deleting item "Calebasses Branch Road" and its corresponding entries and replacing it by the following item and its corresponding entries —

Calebasses Branch Road	From its junction with A2 at Calebasses to its junction with B11 at Arsenal, including the link up to interchange in Motorway M3 at Calebasses	B97

4. These regulations shall come into operation on 27 December 2021.
