

Medical Council (Exemption from Examination) (Amendment) Regulations 2014

THE MEDICAL COUNCIL ACT

Regulations made by the Minister, after consultation with the Medical Council, under section 42(1)(a) of the Medical Council Act

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Medical Council (Exemption from Examination) (Amendment) Regulations 2014**.
- 2.** In these regulations —
“principal regulations” means the Medical Council (Exemption from Examination) Regulations 2013.
- 3.** Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the following regulation —
 - 3.** For the purposes of section 22(3) of the Act, a person shall be exempted from undergoing the examination referred to in section 22(1)(ca) of the Act where —
 - (a) he establishes to the satisfaction of the Council that he is duly registered as a general practitioner with the regulatory body of the country where he was practising medicine immediately before he applies for registration in Mauritius and he has practised as a general practitioner for a minimum period of 3 years in that country; or
 - (b) before 1 August 2013, he was registered as a preregistration trainee under section 20 of the Act.
- 4.** These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 19 September 2013.
