# Municipal Council of Vacoas-Phoenix (Fees for Classified Trades) Regulations 2014

## THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 2011

## Regulations made by the Municipal Council of Vacoas-Phoenix

 under sections 122, 158, and 163 of the Local Government Act 20111. These regulations may be cited as the Municipal Council of Vacoas-Phoenix (Fees for Classified Trades) Regulations 2014.
2. The fees specified in the second column of the schedule shall be levied in respect of the corresponding classified trades specified in the first column of that schedule.
3. Any fees, dues, or other charges payable in respect of any classified trade specified in part A, under theseregulations in respect of any financial year, shall be due on 1 January of that year and shall be paid by the person -
(a) within 15 days after the start of the classified trade; and
(b) thereafter in respect of every subsequent financial year in 2 equalinstalments, the first one on or before 31 January and the second one onor before 31 July next ensuing.
4. A surcharge of 50 per cent shall be levied on any amount not paid within the period specified in regulation 3.
5. Where a person starts carrying a classified trade on or after the $1^{\text {st }}$ July, he shall pay 50 per cent of the prescribed fee for that financial year.
6. No prosecution in respect of a person's failure to pay the fees, dues, and charges, under the schedule to these regulations shall be instituted before 31 days, after the expiry period of the trade fees, dues, and charges.
7. Any person who contravenes these regulations shall commit an offence and shall on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding Rs 25,000.
8. The Municipal Council of Vacoas-Phoenix (Fees for Classified Trades) Regulations 2013, (Government Notice No. 315 of 2013), is repealed.
9. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 January 2014.
