**Regulations made by the Municipal Council of Vacoas-Phoenix under section 163 of the
Local Government Act 2011.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Municipal Council of Vacoas-Phoenix (Fees for Classified Trade) (Amendment) Regulations 2015**.

2. In these regulations –

“principal regulations” means the regulations published under Municipal Council of Vacoas-
Phoenix (Fees for Classified Trade) Regulations 2014.

3. Part A of the Schedule of the Principal regulations is revoked and replaced as Part A set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

4. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation in 1 January 2015.
