

# Merchant Shipping (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2014

## THE MERCHANT SHIPPING ACT

### Regulations made by the Minister under section 228 of the Merchant Shipping Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Merchant Shipping (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2014**.

2. In these regulations —  
“principal regulations” means the Merchant Shipping (Fees) Regulations 2009.

3. The Schedule to the principal regulations is amended —

(a) in Part II —

(i) by deleting item 2 and replacing it by the following item —

2.	Issue of continuation of seafarer's discharge book	Rs 300

(ii) in item 3, by deleting the words “Rs 500” and replacing them by the words “Rs 700”;

(iii) by adding the following new items —

10.	Processing fee for issue of new seafarer's discharge book	Rs 500

11. Opening of Articles of Agreement	Rs 2,000 per Articles of Agreement

(b) in Part III, by inserting, after item 6, the following new items —

6A. Issue of Certificate of Competency	USD 100
6B. Issue of Certificate of Proficiency	USD 50

(c) in Part IV, by adding the following new items —

25. Dry dock survey of yacht	Rs 2,000
26. For every re-inspection of yacht after the first inspection following the issue of a deficiency list, to ensure that a deficiency has been rectified to the satisfaction of the surveyor	Rs 500
27. Issue or re-issue of Declaration of Maritime Labour Compliance	USD 100
28. Issue of Certificate of financial insurance or other financial security (CLC/Bunker) for civil liability for oil pollution damage	USD 100
29. Issue of Certificate under an international convention	USD 100

(d) by adding the following new Part —

MISCELLANEOUS**

**Fees**

1. Issue of outward port clearance	Rs 500 per outward port clearance
2. Issue of exemption or dispensation	USD 50

**4.** These regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 2014.
