Maritime Zones (Economic Activities) (Amendment) Regulations 2022

THE MARITIME ZONES ACT

Regulations made by the Prime Minister under sections 21A, 21B and 27 of the Maritime Zones Act

1. These regulations maybe cited as the **Maritime Zones (Economic Activities)** (Amendment) Regulations 2022.

2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Maritime Zones (Economic Activities) Regulations 2014.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new definition, the full stop at the end of the definition "deep sea water" being deleted and replaced by a semicolon -

"marine renewable energy" refers to, inter alia, energy contained in, or transported by, ocean tides, waves, currents, salinity, heat content or offshore winds.

4. The Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by deleting item 5 and its corresponding entries and replacing it by the following item and its corresponding entries –

5. Technologies for energy conversion An activity that uses appropriate and production from marine renewable energy resources
An activity that uses appropriate technology for the conversion and production of energy from marine renewable energy resources

5. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 October 2022.
