

National Identity Card (Amendment) Regulations 2015

THE NATIONAL IDENTITY CARD ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 10 of the National Identity Card Act

1. These regulations may be cited as **the National Identity Card (Amendment) Regulations 2015**.

2. In these regulations —

“principal regulations” means the National Identity Card Regulations 2013.

3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended —

(a) under the heading “**DETAILS OF APPLICANT**”, by deleting the following words —

Fingerprint captured —

.....
Right slap (4 fingers)	left slap (4 fingers)	right thumb/left Thumb

and replacing them by the following words —

Fingerprint captured —

.....
Right slap (4 fingers)	Left slap (4 fingers)	Right thumb and left thumb

NOTE — Only 4 best fingerprint minutiae shall be used for identity verification.

(b) under the heading “**DECLARATION OF APPLICANT**”, by adding the following new paragraph, the word “and” at the end of paragraph (b) being deleted and the full stop at the end of paragraph (c) being deleted and replaced by the words “; and” —

(d) I have no objection that my fingerprint minutiae be processed and recorded for the purpose of producing my identity card. I understand that this information will be erased permanently from the register once the identity card has been printed.

4. These regulations shall come into operation on 14 September 2015.
