#### THE POLICE ACT

# Order made by the Commissioner of Police, with the approval of the Minister, under section 13A of the Police Act

- 1. Notice is hereby given that by virtue of the powers vested in me under section 13A of the Police Act, I hereby consider it necessary, in the interest of public safety and public order, to order that the portion of land of the extent of 4938m² (1A 17), being part of Pas Géometriques Albion, in the district of Black River, and more fully described in the Schedule, shall be a protected area.
- 2. The only persons entitled to enter and remain in the protected area are those who have, been authorised in writing by the Commissioner of Police of any other person authorised by him.
- 3. Any police officer or a member of the armed forces may
  - (a) take such measures as he considers necessary to ensure that no person prohibited from entering or remaining in the protected area enters or remains in that area;
  - (b) arrest and remove any person who, without lawful authority, attempts to enter the protected area;
  - (c) arrest and remove any person who, without lawful authority, is found in the protected area.
- **4.** Any person who, without lawful authority, enters or remains in the protected area shall commit an offence.

### **SCHEDULE**

## [Paragraph 1]

The portion of land of the extent of 4938m² (1A 17), being part of Pas Géometriques Albion, in the district of Black River, is bounded as follows –

- (a) towards the North-East by surplus of Pas Géometriques Albion on one hundred and nine metres and fifty centimetres (109.50m);
- (b) towards the South by surplus of Pas Géometriques Albion on two lines measuring one hundred and one metre and thirty centimetres (101.30m) and thirty-two metres (32.00m), respectively; and
- (c) towards the North-West by the High Water Mark of the sea.
