THE PHARMACY ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 47 of the Pharmacy Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Pharmacy (Restriction on Use of Stilbenes, Stilbene Derivative, their Salts and Esters and Thyrostatic Substances in Animal Production or Aquaculture Products) Regulations 2015**.

2. In these regulations —

“substance” means a substance specified in the Schedule.

3. (1) Any pharmacist who sells a substance shall cause the purchaser of the substance to make an entry in the Poisons Book declaring that the substance shall not be used in animal production or aquaculture products.

(2) Any person who —

(a) uses a substance in animal production or aquaculture products; or

(b) makes a false statement for the purpose of obtaining the delivery of a substance,

shall commit an offence.
