THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT ACT

Regulations made by the Minister, on the recommendation of the Procurement Policy Office, under section 61 of the Public Procurement Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the **Public Procurement (Amendment No. 3) Regulations** 2023.
- 2. In these regulations
 - "principal regulations" means the Public Procurement Regulations 2008.
- 3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the definition of "parastatal body".
- **4.** Regulations 2A and 2B of the principal regulations are revoked and replaced by the following regulations –

2A. Non-application of Act

The Act shall not apply to a public body specified in the first column of the First Schedule with regard to such contract as specified in the second column of that Schedule.

2B. Application of Act

- (1) The Act shall apply to a public body specified in the first column of the Eighth Schedule.
- (2) The prescribed amount for a public body shall, in respect of a type of contract specified in the second column of the Eighth Schedule, be that specified in the third column of that Schedule.
- **5.** The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after regulation 2B, the following new regulation –

2C. Non-application of Parts III, IV, V and VI of Act

Parts III, IV, V and VI of the Act shall not apply to the procurement of goods, works, consultancy services or other services specified in the Ninth Schedule.

6. The principal regulations are amended by adding the Eighth Schedule and Ninth Schedule set out in the First Schedule and Second Schedule to these regulations, respectively.

7.	These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 20 July 2023.
