# Regulations made by the Minister, on the recommendation of the Procurement Policy Office, under section 61 of the Public Procurement Act

- These regulations may be cited as the Public Procurement (Amendment of Schedule)
   (No. 3) Regulations 2022.
- 2. In these regulations —

"Act" means the Public Procurement Act.

- 3. The First Schedule to the Act is amended
  - (a) by revoking Part I and replacing it by the following Part —
