THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT ACT

Regulations made by the Minister, on the recommendation of the Procurement Policy Office, under section 61 of the Public Procurement Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Public Procurement (Amendment of Schedule) (No. 3) Regulations 2022**.
2. In these regulations —
“Act” means the Public Procurement Act.
3. The First Schedule to the Act is amended —
 - (a) by revoking Part I and replacing it by the following Part —

- (b) in Part II, in Column 3, by deleting the words “50 million” wherever they appear and replacing them by the words “70 million”;
- (c) by revoking Part III and replacing it by the following Part —

- (d) in Part IV, in Column 3, by deleting the words “100 million” wherever they appear and replacing them by the words “135 million”;
- (e) by revoking Part V and replacing it by the following Part —

State Trading Corporation

4. The Second Schedule to the Act is amended —
- (a) by numbering the existing provisions as items 1 to 5;
- (b) in the newly numbered item 2, by revoking paragraph (c) and replacing it by the following paragraph —
- (c) vessels, including chartering, maintenance, repairs, related consultancy or brokerage services and periodic overhauls in a dry dock
