

# **Private Secondary Education (Amendment) Regulations 2023**

## **THE PRIVATE SECONDARY EDUCATION AUTHORITY ACT**

### **Regulations made by the Minister under section 22 of the Private Secondary Education Authority Act**

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Private Secondary Education (Amendment) Regulations 2023**.
- 2.** In these regulations -  
  
"principal regulations" means the Private Secondary Education Regulations 1977.
- 3.** Regulation 7A of the principal regulations is amended -
  - (a) in paragraph (2), by deleting the words "1 June of the school year in which he, is admitted, no student shall be maintained in" and replacing them by the words "1 January of the school year in which he is admitted, no student shall remain in";
  - (b) by revoking paragraph (2A) and replacing it by the following new paragraph -
    - (2A) Notwithstanding paragraph (2)(a), except with the approval of the Minister, or where a student, who is born between 2000 and 2016 joins Grade 7 at the age of 14 on 1 January of the school year in which he is admitted, no student who is born between 2000 and 2016 shall remain in a secondary school up to the end of the school year in which he attains the age of 21.
  - (c) in paragraph (3)(b)(i), by deleting the words "1 June" and replacing them by the words "1 January";
  - (d) by adding the following new paragraph -
    - (4) Notwithstanding paragraph (3)(b)(i), a student who, is born between 2000 and 2016 shall, not be admitted to Grade 12 unless he is aged 20 years or less on 1 January of the year of his proposed admission.
- 4.** These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2022.
