THE EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 94 of the Employment Relations Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Public Transport (Buses) Workers (Remuneration Order) (Amendment) Regulations 2014**.

2. In these regulations –

"principal regulations" means the Public Transport (Buses) Workers (Remuneration Order) Regulations 2008.

3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (2), by deleting the words "Additional Remuneration (2013) Act 2012" and replacing them by the words "Additional Remuneration (2014) Act 2013".
