

Quarantine (COVID-19 Restrictions) (Amendment) Regulations 2023

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THE QUARANTINE ACT 2020

Regulations made by the Minister under section 13 of the Quarantine Act 2020

- 1.** These regulations may be cited as the **Quarantine (COVID-19 Restrictions) (Amendment) Regulations 2023**.
- 2.** In these regulations –
"principal regulations" means the Quarantine (COVID-19 Restrictions) Regulations 2022.
- 3.** Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new definition, the full stop at the end of the definition of "self-confined person" being deleted and replaced by a semicolon –
"specified institution" means an institution listed in the Fourth Schedule.
- 4.** Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking paragraph (1) and replacing it by the following paragraph –
(1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3), a person who is tested to be infected with COVID-19 shall, from the day he has been tested to be infected with COVID-19, be self-confined for such period as a registered medical practitioner may determine.
- 5.** The Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the Fourth Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 6.** These regulations shall come into operation on 4 September 2023.

4.	Child care services establishment	Establishment providing child care services under the Children's Act 2020
