THE RADIATION PROTECTION ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under sections 19 and 24 of the Radiation Protection Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Radiation Protection (Safe Transport of Radioactive Material) Regulations 2016.
- 2. In these regulations -

"transport" means the deliberate physical movement of radioactive material, other than that forming part of the means of propulsion, from one place to another.

- 3. Every person who is authorised to transport radioactive material shall -
 - (a) ensure that the radioactive material is transported in accordance with the relevant technical requirements of the regulations for the safe transport of radioactive materials specified in the Schedule;
 - (b) provide such information as the Authority may require to prove that he has complied with these regulations.
- **4.** These regulations shall come into operation on 1 May 2016.
