

Social Aid (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations 2015

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THE SOCIAL AID ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 11 of the Social Aid Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Social Aid (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations 2015**.

2. In these regulations —

“Act” means the Social Aid Act.

3. The First Schedule to the Act is amended —

(a) in Part I —

(i) in items 1 and 2, by deleting the figure “1,147” and replacing it by the figure “1,196”;

(ii) by deleting item 3 and its corresponding entries and replacing it by the following item and its corresponding entries —

3. Child’s allowance for every child —

(a) under the age of 3 466

(b) aged not less than 3 and under the age of 10 447

(c) aged not less than 10 and under the age of 15 546

(d) who is receiving full-time education, aged not less than 15 and until the end of the school year in which the child attains the age of 20	681
(e) aged not less than 15 nor more than 20 and who is unable to earn a living through physical or mental disability and is not in receipt of a benefit under the National Pensions Act	1,196
(f) aged not less than 20 nor more than 23, who is pursuing a full-time course at a tertiary education institution	681

(iii) in items 4, 5 and 10, by deleting the figures “681”, “866” and “4,318” and replacing them by the figures “710”, “903” and “4,504”, respectively;

(b) in Part II, by deleting the figure “815” and replacing it by the figure “850”;

(c) in Part III —

(i) in item 1, by deleting the figure “1,201” and replacing it by the figure “1,253”;

(ii) by deleting item 2 and its corresponding entries and replacing it by the following item and its corresponding entries —

(a) Under the age of 3	487
(b) aged not less than 3 and under the age of 10	467
(c) aged not less than 10 and under the age of 15	570
(d) aged not less than 15 and who is receiving full-time education, until	713

	the end of the school year in which	
	the child attains the age of 20	
(e)	aged not less than 15 nor more	1,253
	than 20 and who is unable to earn	
	a living through any physical	
	or mental disability and is not	
	in receipt of a benefit under the	
	National Pensions Act	
(f)	aged not less than 20 nor more than	713
	23, who is pursuing a full-time course	
	at a tertiary education institution	

(iii) in items 3, 4 and 9, by deleting the figures “713”, “905” and “4,318” and replacing them by the figures “744”, “944” and “4,504”, respectively.

4. The Third Schedule to the Act is repealed and replaced by the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
5. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2013.
