Sugar Industry (Non-Agricultural Workers) (Remuneration Order) (Amendment) Regulations 2015

THE EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 94 of the Employment Relations Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Sugar Industry (Non-Agricultural Workers)** (Remuneration Order) (Amendment) Regulations 2015.

2. In these regulations –

"principal regulations" means the Sugar Industry (Non-Agricultural Workers) (Remuneration Order) Regulations 1985.

3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (5), by deleting the words "Additional Remuneration (2014) Act 2013" and replacing them by the words "Additional Remuneration (2015) Act 2014".

4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

5. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph 1, by deleting the words "279.42 rupees for a normal day's work during crop and 330.22 rupees during intercrop" and replacing them by the words "336.84 rupees for a normal day's work during crop and 398.08 rupees during intercrop".

6. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2015.
